The House of St Barnabas (HoSB) is a charity pledging to break the cycle of homelessness. We run a social business, our members' club in our Grade I listed home on Soho Square to help people prosper through paid employment, allowing them to break their cycle of homelessness.

We have an exciting opportunity to join our Kitchen Team, as a Sous Chef. You will help our team of chefs run the food service, and keep the back-of-house catering areas in tip-top condition.

There will be plenty of opportunity for training, mentoring & progression from this role.

What we offer:
